

Audit Period Schedule 2022

The AMAA (CAB) audit requirement is based on the type of publication and the frequency of publication. All **Community Newspapers** must audit each 12-month audit period.

Business and Professional Publications or Specialty Publications or Community Language Publications or Community Language Newspapers that publish 12 issues or less per year can audit a 12-month period – either April to March or October to September following by a Publisher's Statement.

The following are the defined audit periods, lodgement and data release dates for 2022.

6-month audit periods

1 October 2021 to 31 March 2022

Deadline to send records & eLodgement for MAD audited publications: **Friday April 15, 2022** Deadline eLodgement Date (other than MAD audited publications): **Friday April 29, 2022** eData Release: Friday May 20, 2022

1 April 2022 to 30 September 2022

Deadline to send records and eLodgement for MAD audited publications: **Friday October 14, 2022** Deadline eLodgement Date (other than MAD audited publications): **Monday October 31, 2022** eData Release: Friday November 25, 2022

12-month audit periods

1 April 2021 to 31 March 2022

Deadline to send records & eLodgement for MAD audited publications: **Friday April 15, 2022** Deadline eLodgement Date (other than MAD audited publications): **Friday April 29, 2022** eData Release: Friday May 20, 2022

1 October 2021 to 30 September 2022

Deadline to send records and eLodgement for MAD audited publications: **Friday October 14, 2022** Deadline eLodgement Date (other than MAD audited publications): **Monday October 31, 2022** eData Release: Friday November 25, 2022
